



Curriculum



An incubator with fertile Chicken Eggs have been delivered from the "Living Eggs" program. The children observed nine healthy chicks hatch from the eggs and then have been involved in the care and observation of the developing chicks. Through this fascinating process the children are learning about the chicken life cycle and are involved in various numeracy and literacy experiences including counting and recording of eggs and hatched chicks, sequencing life cycle pictures and still life drawing. Children will also develop an understanding of the difference between fertile and infertile eggs and discuss the animals that give birth to live young compared with egg laying animals.
